



VOTING INTENTIONS POLL

Published 9th November 2009

A poll was conducted by TNS-BMRB to establish current voting intentions in Scotland in relation to both the Holyrood and Westminster Parliaments.

The results of this poll were published in The Herald on 9th November 2009.

TNS-BMRB is a member of the British Polling Council (BPC) and abides by its rules. We also operate within the Code of Conduct of the Market Research Society (MRS). In accordance with these rules the following information is provided:

Fieldwork dates	28th October – 3rd November
Interview method	Face-to-face, in-home
Population sampled	All adults aged 18+ in Scotland
Sampling method	The poll was conducted through our Omnibus, Scottish Opinion Survey. For this survey, sampling points are selected to be representative of Scotland demographically and geographically. Within each sampling point, a quota sampling method is used for respondent selection.
Data weighting	Data are weighted to the profile of all adults aged 18+ in Scotland, based on population profile estimates from the National Readership Survey. Weighting is carried out in relation to working status within gender, age, social grade and electoral region. Unweighted and weighted bases are shown at the top of each data table.
Voting intentions	Two tables are supplied for each measure of voting intentions. The first of these is based on all respondents and shows the percentages 'uncommitted' – i.e. who were either undecided, refused to say how they might vote or said that they would not vote at all. The second table excludes this 'uncommitted' group and re-percentages party support based on all those naming a party. It is these latter figures which are published as the measure of voting intentions. Results are shown for both the constituency and regional votes for Holyrood.
